The world's best preserved meteorite impact site on Earth is located right here in Arizona. Located just minutes from Interstate 40 and the old Route 66 in Northern Arizona near Winslow, Meteor Crater is the spectacular result of a collision that rocked the American Southwest approximately 50,000 years ago with the energy of more than 20 million tons of TNT. Situated under the wide skies of the Arizona High Desert, Meteor Crater offers an interactive educational experience for the

entire family in a beautiful, natural setting. Meteor Crater is nearly one mile across, 2.4 miles in circumference and more than 550 feet deep. It is an International tourist venue with Outdoor Observation Trails, Air Conditioned Indoor Viewing, Wide Screen Movie Theater, Interactive Discovery Center and Unique Gift and Rock Shop. Food is also available inside the Visitor Center located at the rim of the crater.

BREATHE EASY WITH A NEW CABIN AIR FILTER



You love everything about spring...well, almost everything. You love the warmer temperatures, spending time outside and hearing the birds chirp, but can do without the allergy-inducing pollen that invades the air.

If you suffer from allergies, you go through this love-hate relationship with spring every year. While you can't magically get rid of all the pollen in the air, you can ensure the air inside your car is clean and fresh with a new cabin air filter.

You are probably aware that your vehicle's engine has an air filter, but did you know that your car's HVAC (heating ventilation and air conditioning) system may also have one? Commonly called a cabin air filter, it performs the same duties for your HVAC system as the engine air filter does for your car's engine.

Clean air is essential to your vehicle running properly; your car's engine air filter ensures

that clean air reaches the engine. In the same way, your car's ventilation system counts on the cabin air filter to keep a steady stream of clean air flowing.

The cabin air filter keeps dust, dirt, pollen, bacteria and exhaust gases from entering the HVAC system of your car. It also prevents bugs, leaves and other debris from clogging up the system. Vital to clean air inside the car, the cabin air filter keeps the air inside the car fresh so you and your passengers can breathe easy – something you'll appreciate all year long but especially during allergy season.

It is recommended that you change your cabin air filter annually or every 12,000 miles. Allergy sufferers may want to consider changing it more often to ensure air quality and to reduce their allergy symptoms.



Andes Mint Cookies

Andes Mint Cookies are a soft-baked chocolate cookie loaded with Andes Mint pieces and spread with an extra layer of mint goodness. They're delicious straight from the oven.



INGREDIENTS

| 1/2 cup butter, softened | 1 cup flour |
| 1/2 cup white sugar | 1/2 cup cocoa |
| 1/2 cup brown sugar | 1 teaspoon baking soda |
| 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract | 1/2 teaspoon salt |
| 1/4 teaspoon mint extract | 3/4 cup Andes mint baking pieces |
| 1 egg | 24 Andes mints |

DIRECTIONS

1. In a large bowl, beat the softened butter until light colored. Cream in white and brown sugar. Beat in the vanilla and mint extract and the egg.
2. In a separate bowl, combine the flour, baking soda, salt and cocoa. Stir into the wet ingredients. Stir in the Andes mint pieces.
3. Roll the dough into 1 inch balls and refrigerate for at least 2 hours.
4. Preheat the oven to 350 F. Place the balls on a cookie sheet and bake in a preheated oven for 9-11 minutes. Do not overbake or they will be crunchy.
5. Remove them from the oven and immediately place 1 and 1/2 Andes mints on the top of the cookie. Let them sit for a minute until the mint has melted and then gently spread on the cookie with a knife. Let them cool completely before storing, Or enjoy them warm.
